YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

At Amaanah, empowering young people is at the heart of everything we do. Through our Youth Empowerment Services, we are dedicated to breaking down barriers, creating opportunities, and fostering a brighter future for students across our community. Over the past year, our programs have positively impacted more than 3,000 students, and we are proud to play a role in shaping their journeys toward success.

One of our most significant accomplishments has been awarding 20 scholarships totaling \$50,000 to deserving students. These scholarships provide crucial financial support, enabling young people to pursue their educational dreams without the burden of financial insecurity. For us, this isn't just an investment in individuals; it's an investment in the future of our community.

Our commitment to education extends beyond scholarships. We have supported eight schools across the community, ensuring they have the resources and tools to provide students with quality education. From classroom supplies to tailored programs, our efforts enhance learning environments and create a foundation for student success.

To address the diverse needs of our community, we've hired 10 Language Acquisition Coaches (LACs) directly from within the neighborhoods we serve. These professionals provide invaluable support by working with students in 11 different languages. Their work ensures that language barriers never hinder a child's ability to learn, grow, or feel included.

Diversity is central to our mission. We are privileged to support students from 24 different countries, fostering a culture of inclusivity and mutual

respect. By celebrating this rich diversity, we create a welcoming environment where every student feels valued and empowered to succeed.



GUIDING STARS

This initiative is centered around the creation of upcycled products from discarded clothing and textiles. By providing comprehensive skills development, business support, and sustainability education, the project aims to foster self-sufficiency among refugee women. Through

this endeavor, we seek to achieve multifaceted impacts: economic empowerment, environmental sustainability through waste reduction, the promotion of gender equality, and the creation of a supportive community.

Ultimately, the project's success will be measured not only by the upcycled products it produces, but also by the lasting positive changes it brings to the lives of those involved, leading to a more equitable and sustainable future.

YEXSI'S STORY



The journey was not easy. There are no words sufficient to describe what we went through: sleepless nights, fear of being detained, walking without knowing if we would reach the next city. We met generous people, but also others who made us feel less human. There were moments of complete despair, like when my daughter got sick, and we had neither the means nor the help to get her medical care. Or when we met other desperate immigrants who

were just trying to survive. But here we are, after crossing seven countries and facing countless challenges. We arrived in the United States—a place full of promises but also full of difficulties. I don't know what the future holds, but what I do know is that although we have suffered greatly, we have also learned a lot. And that's what keeps me strong: the hope that in this country, our daughter will have a chance, a dignified life, far from the violence and poverty we left behind.

This is how our stay began in a country so different from our culture. Thanks to God, I met a teacher from my daughter's school. She gave me a number and said, "Keep it and call—it will help you a lot." I called insistently because we had nowhere to sleep and nothing to eat. We slept on the floor, and every day our lives were filled with sadness. But we continued trusting in God, believing that things would improve.

Days went by, and I received a call from a woman who told me there was only one spot left—and it was mine—

to attend English classes. What joy! Little by little, I became part of the Amaanah program through the Big Sisters. To my greatest surprise, I was selected for a complete renovation of my home—a tremendous blessing for me and my family. That day will forever be unforgettable for us. To me, Amaanah means so much—a foundation that helps those in need regardless of race, color, or religion. I will always be grateful to the entire team for the support we received and for giving me the opportunity to say that you can count on me to continue moving forward on this journey of life.

Sometimes sadness overwhelms me when I remember everything we've lost. But I am also grateful for everything we've gained: strength, resilience, and above all, the unity of our family. If this journey has taught me anything, it's that despite the suffering, family is the most valuable thing we have. And no matter how far we are from home, we will always be together, facing whatever comes. Thank you, Amaanah, for your blessings.

WOMEN'S PROGRAMS

This year our programs brought new hope and new futures to women from a wide erray of backgrounds.

Amaanah Refugee Services'
Women's Empowerment Programs
are designed to uplift and empower
refugee women, equipping them
with the skills, confidence, and
resources they need to thrive in their
new communities. These programs
focus on fostering independence,
building community connections, and
promoting personal and professional
growth.

At the core of these initiatives is the belief that empowering women is essential to creating resilient families and stronger communities. Through workshops, mentorship opportunities, and cultural integration activities, refugee women are supported in navigating challenges such as language barriers, cultural adaptation, and employment readiness. Amaanah provides tools and training that help participants enhance their financial literacy, improve their English language skills, and access career pathways, enabling them to achieve self-sufficiency and long-term success.

A key aspect of Amaanah's Women's Empowerment Programs is creating a supportive environment where women can build relationships with peers and mentors. Programs such as the Big Sisters Circle connect refugee women with compassionate

volunteers who provide guidance, friendship, and encouragement. These connections help women build confidence, overcome isolation, and develop a sense of belonging in their new communities.

Beyond skill-building, the programs also focus on holistic well-being. Initiatives such as wellness workshops and community outings offer opportunities for women to focus on their mental and emotional health while embracing joy and creativity. For example, a visit to the Seismique Art Installation gave participants a chance to explore art, self-expression, and camaraderie in a unique and inspiring setting.

By fostering independence, self-confidence, and connection, Amaanah's Women's Empowerment Programs play a vital role in transforming the lives of refugee women, ensuring they have the support and tools needed to create brighter futures for themselves and their families.
