


2025 MID-YEAR REPORT





EMPOWERMENT

What is Empowerment Program?

Launched as part of Amaanah's holistic wraparound services, our Empowerment Program focuses on three core areas:

BIG SISTER CIRCLE PROGRAM



Through financial literacy workshops, employment readiness, and access to social services, we support women in gaining the tools they need to become financially independent.

COMMUNITY BUILDING:

The women participate in support circles, cultural outings, and community events, allowing them to build lasting friendships and local Networks.

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT:

Monthly curriculum-based workshops focus on themes like self-compassion, parenting in a new culture, leadership, mental health, and self-advocacy. Activities are always culturally responsive and often translated live into the participants' native languages.

Each woman in the program is also paired with a mentor through our Big Sister Circle (BSC), a specialized initiative that provides one-on-one guidance, goal setting, and ongoing emotional support.

BIG SISTER CIRCLE PROGRAM

PARTICIPATION:

22 refugee women meeting **8 hrs/month** for culturally sensitive life-skills, parenting, and self-care sessions

STAFFING:

Hired 2 part-time community members as peer facilitators

CURRICULUM:

Designed a February–December empowerment curriculum (civic leadership, financial literacy, self compassion, career readiness, etc.) – live-translated each month

- Resume-building clinic
- Multiple guest speakers from law, health, and financial sectors



Introducing Borderless: Amaanah's Reimagined Initiative for Refugee Women

Amaanah is proud to announce the launch of Borderless, in collaboration with Imiloa Collective this dynamic new initiative under our Empowerment pillar, designed to uplift and invest in the potential of refugee women. Formerly known as the Community CLOTH program, Borderless represents a reimagined and expanded vision—focused on supporting women in building sustainable livelihoods from the comfort of their homes.





Borderless empowers participants through a holistic model that includes small business development, entrepreneurship training, health and wellness resources, and financial literacy. By creating and selling handmade crafts and wares, refugee women are not only generating income—they are also preserving and sharing their unique cultural heritage.

This initiative fosters independence, creativity, and connection, helping women turn skills into opportunity while honoring their identities. Through Borderless, Amaanah reaffirms its commitment to breaking down barriers and creating pathways for refugee women to thrive—economically, emotionally, and socially.

Task Force

The Power of Community: Amaanah's New Empowerment Task Forces

In 2025, Amaanah launched a strategic initiative to deepen and expand the impact of our Empowerment Services through the creation of **two dedicated Task Forces**—one for Education and one for Empowerment.

These task forces were created in response to a growing need: while our programs have made significant strides in helping refugee and immigrant families stabilize and succeed, the scale of need and opportunity continues to grow. To meet it, we knew we needed more than services—we needed collective vision, collaboration, and accountability.

What Are the Task Forces?

Each task force is composed of community leaders, professionals, former program participants, and Amaanah staff, working together to shape the future of our empowerment efforts. These are not advisory boards in name only—they are active, hands-on contributors who support strategy, fundraising, partnership development, and community engagement.

Both women and youth in refugee communities often remain underrepresented in civic, educational, and workforce conversations. The task forces help amplify their voices by creating advocacy campaigns, community events, and partnerships with schools, clinics, local businesses, and city leaders.

Focused Growth Strategy



Each task force is helping to develop a strategic growth plan—expanding Teach360 to more schools, enhancing the Guiding Stars scholarship mentorship model, and scaling the Big Sister Circle program to include new leadership tracks and entrepreneurship training.





Amaanah's Partnership with PV Extension

Thanks to our collaboration with PV Extension, Amaanah gained access to the Grow with Google, a special training and support pipeline made available to organizations serving underrepresented communities.

Through this partnership:

- Participants in Education programs now have access to Grow with Google training and certifications.
- PV Extension provides technical support and facilitation, ensuring women and youth feel confident navigating the online learning platform.
- Participants can receive guidance in selecting career-aligned learning tracks, whether their goal is to enter the workforce, start a small business, or advance in school.
- The partnership also connects Amaanah participants to additional PV resources such as financial literacy, entrepreneurship training, and wellness education.

Why This Matters

For refugee and immigrant families, access to career-aligned, skill-based education is life-changing. Many arrive in the U.S. with interrupted schooling, language barriers, or unfamiliarity with digital tools. Grow with Google, delivered through this meaningful partnership, gives Amaanah participants the chance to:

- · Access credentialed learning without cost
- Increase employment opportunities
- Regain confidence and independence

Together, Amaanah and PV Extension are creating a bridge to opportunity, ensuring that the women and youth we serve are not left behind in the digital economy.

18th Annual Back-to-School Drive with Rupani Foundation

Amaanah is honored to partner with the Rupani Foundation to co-host the 18th Annual Back-to-School Drive, taking place on July 26, 2025, in Houston. This large-scale event aims to distribute 5,000 backpacks filled with school supplies to refugee children and immigrant families across the Greater Houston area.

Amaanah was invited to lead the volunteer coordination for this initiative, working closely with ExxonMobil lead engineer Brian Lee to recruit and mobilize over 60 volunteers. Surpassing expectations, Amaanah successfully registered 120 volunteers and secured 300 backpacks specifically for Amaanah's clients—ensuring that children from our most vulnerable communities are equipped for a strong start to the school year.

Beyond direct service, Amaanah is committed to inclusive outreach by connecting with smaller grassroots organizations to identify families in need. Through this continued effort, we are working to ensure that no child is left behind and that all students have the tools they need to thrive academically.

Grow with Google: Expanding Digital Access Through Strategic Partnership In our ongoing commitment to provide refugee and immigrant communities with tools for long-term success, Amaanah Refugee Services has partnered with the Prairie View A&M University Extension Program (PV Extension) to bring Grow with Google training directly to our Women's and Youth Empowerment participants.

What is Grow with Google?

Grow with Google is a nationwide initiative designed to help individuals develop in-demand digital and job-readiness skills—all at no cost. Through self-paced online training, participants can earn industry-recognized certifications in high-growth fields, gain confidence in using digital tools, and improve their employability in today's Workforce.

Participants can choose from pathways such as:

- > IT Support
- Data Analytics
- Project Management
- Digital Marketing & E-Commerce
- > UX Design

The program also includes support for building resumes, preparing for interviews, and learning essential tools like Google Docs, Sheets, and Gmail.

RESUME BUILDING CLASS WITH PETROPLAN





Empowering Refugee & Immigrant Communities for Workforce Readiness As part of our ongoing commitment to preparing our participants for meaningful employment, Amaanah Refugee Services partnered with Petroplan, a global talent acquisition and workforce solutions company specializing in the energy sector, to host a hands-on Resume Building Workshop for women and youth in our empowerment programs.

About the Workshop

The class was designed to provide practical, personalized guidance to participants who are preparing to enter or re-enter the job market in the United States. For many of the attendees—refugee and immigrant women and first-generation college students—this was their first time creating a U.S.-style resume.

The session covered:

- How to format a professional resume
- Identifying transferrable skills from previous work or life experiences
- Writing strong bullet points using action verbs
- How to highlight volunteer work, certifications, and language fluency
- Tips for tailoring resumes to specific industries or jobs



Petroplan's Impact

Petroplan not only provided expert facilitators from their recruiting team, but also brought a culturally sensitive and empowering approach to the training. They offered:

- > One-on-one resume reviews
- > Real-time feedback
- > Examples of resumes across various industries
- > Insight into how hiring managers screen resumes and what stands out

Participants walked away with:

- > A completed or revised resume they can use immediately
- > Increased confidence in presenting themselves professionally
- > Knowledge of how to navigate job applications and employer expectations

Why It Matters

For the women and youth Amaanah serves, job readiness is not just about employment—it's about dignity, independence, and stability. Many of our participants have strong educational or professional backgrounds in their home countries but lack guidance in navigating the U.S. job market.

This resume workshop with Petroplan is part of a larger effort to bridge that gap and equip our community with the tools they need to advocate for themselves in a competitive job market.

By working with a global leader like Petroplan, Amaanah is ensuring our participants are exposed to real-world industry standards, helping them move forward with clarity, purpose, and professionalism.

ECI COALITION INTERVIEW PARTICIPATION

Amaanah proudly supports the ECI Coalition and recently participated in a collaborative interview highlighting the organization's strategic vision for the future. During the discussion, Amaanah shared its long-term goals, aspirations, and the broader impact of its work within the refugee and immigrant communities. The conversation also addressed the challenges posed by the federal funding freeze, shedding light on how it has affected local families and shaped the coalition's collective priorities moving forward. This engagement reflects Amaanah's ongoing commitment to advocacy, partnership, and building a more resilient support system for underserved populations.

TEXAS NONPROFIT SUMMIT SCHOLARSHIP & LEGISLATIVE ENGAGEMENT

Michelle Shattuck, Amaanah's Senior Operations Manager, was awarded a scholarship to attend the Texas Nonprofit Summit. While in the state capital, she met with key state representatives to advocate for continued investment in refugee communities across Houston. Michelle highlighted Amaanah's impact-driven programs and emphasized the critical role community-based organizations play in advancing equity and opportunity. She also voiced deep concerns over recent federal funding cuts, underscoring how these reductions are causing significant harm to vulnerable populations. Her participation reinforced Amaanah's role as both a service provider and an active voice in policy conversations that shape the future of refugee support in Texas.

Advocacy and Strategic Alignment

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AHMAD ALASWAD VISITS STATE CAPITOL



Executive Director Ahmad Alaswad was invited—twice—to the Texas State Capitol to advocate on behalf of Houston's refugee communities in response to the ongoing federal funding cuts. Drawing from deep experience in legislative spaces, Ahmad approached each visit with clarity, compassion, and purpose.

In meetings with state representatives, he powerfully conveyed the real and growing impact of funding freezes—not only on the thousands of refugees newly resettled in Texas, but also on the community-based organizations that serve them. Ahmad highlighted the stark reality: over 5,200 individuals were resettled in the Houston area in the past year, arriving with hope for a better future but now facing significant hardship due to shrinking support systems.

Ahmad's long-term vision includes bringing the Amaanah team to the Capitol to share stories firsthand—ensuring that the voices of refugees and the communities that uplift them are not just heard, but recognized, respected, and remembered in policymaking decisions.

Advocacy and Strategic Alignment

AMAANAH PARTICIPATES IN QUARTERLY REFUGEE CONSORTIUM MEETINGS

Amaanah remains an active participant in the Quarterly Refugee Consortium Meetings—an essential gathering of Houston-based organizations serving refugee communities. These meetings provide a vital space for collaboration, information sharing, and addressing the pressing challenges faced by service providers and the communities they support.

In light of recent federal funding cuts, the landscape has shifted dramatically. Many long-standing organizations have been forced to downsize or close, and we've had to say farewell to valued colleagues whose work once shaped the local refugee support ecosystem. Despite these setbacks, Amaanah remains committed to showing up, speaking out, and advocating for the needs of refugee families across the region.

By continuing to engage in these consortium meetings, Amaanah helps ensure that the voices of the most vulnerable are not forgotten—and that together, we build a stronger, more resilient network of care.

Program Continuation

AMAANAH AWARDED \$20,000 GRANT TO ADVANCE LANGUAGE ACQUISITION IN HOUSTON SCHOOLS

Amaanah is proud to be awarded a \$20,000 grant to further its language acquisition initiatives in Houston-area schools, thanks to its continued partnership with Emgage and the Houston Endowment. This funding directly supports Teach360, Amaanah's flagship education program, which has empowered over 10,000 students since its launch in 2021.

Operating across more than 50 campuses throughout the Greater Houston area, Teach360 has not only provided critical language support to refugee and immigrant students but has also created employment opportunities for 50+ community mentors and advanced educational access for many participants.

This grant recognizes Amaanah's commitment to championing the voiceless—ensuring that language is never a barrier to success for refugee children. Looking ahead, Amaanah is focused on expanding Teach360 to reach every refugee student in Houston and its surrounding communities, building a future where every child has the tools to thrive.


